

HISTORY'S MOST UNDERAPPRECIATED GEM (GIA)

One of the lesser known, yet also one of the most precious gems.

Seldomly seen gem, becomes even more hidden in the market. Known as the master of disguise, treasured for its brilliance and spectacular rare color.

A BIT ABOUT BLACK SPINEL

An opaque stone that comes from the Spinel family.

Ranks 8 on Mohs hardness scale.

Spinel like red, blue, etc. are transparent but black spinel is opaque.

Black Color associated with power, glamour, elegance and confidence.

Mined in Bo Phloi District of the Kanchanaburi Province.





MINING DETAILS

Spinel and corundum are frequently found together!

Thai miners consider presence of black spinel a lucky sign that sapphire is nearby.

Formed by metamorphic activity when molten rock combines with limestone or dolomites.

Leave behind a deposit that resembles a durable mineral within rock.

This mineral is then mined for rare black gemstone.


RARITY

Commonly mistaken for black diamonds.

One of the rarest minerals from the spinel family.

Relatively rare, black spinel is only found in a few areas.

Mined along with ruby and sapphire.



4C's OF BLACK SPINEL

COLOR:

Has a distinctive black coloration, ranging from an inky black to a stark dark.

Has no secondary tones and contains a purely black color.

Excellent choice for anyone who wants to collect black gemstones.

CLARITY:

Possesses no visible flaws, lack of cleavage and a uniform nature.

Once polished, displays a glass-like luster, sparkle, and shine.

Once faceted — able to stunningly reflect light.

CARAT:

Come in all shapes and sizes and can measure up to 18 carats in size.

CUT:

It has rough has inclusions and cracks, making it difficult to cut and set. Once faceted, can offer many shapes including the common ones and fancy ones.
